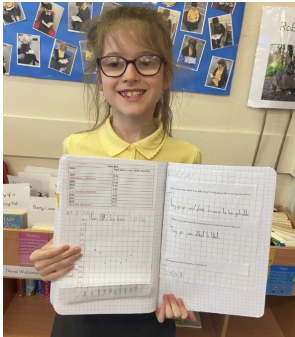




Weekly Bulletin 10 - 2nd July 2021
