**World Mental Health Day.**



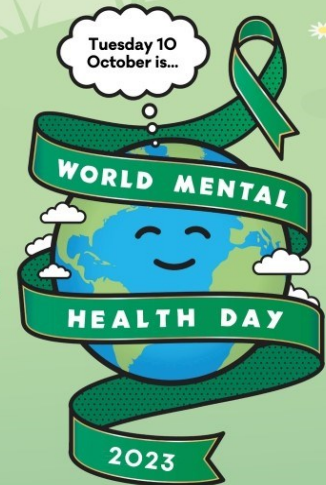
The theme for 2023, set by the World Foundation of Mental Health, is 'Mental health is a universal human right'.

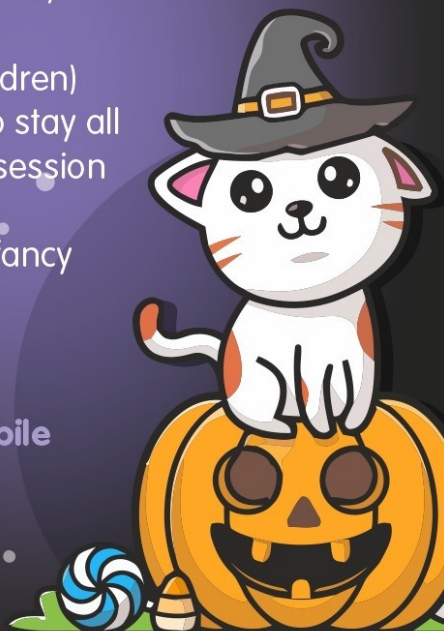
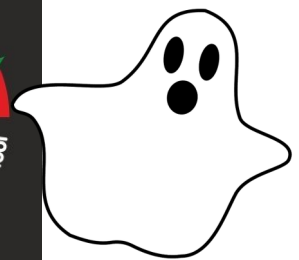
