We are delighted to be able to book and plan some residential visits for next year. Please note there is no option for children just to do this as a day trip. If they commit to this, they need to stay overnight.

As your child will be in Year 2, their Residential visit will be to Conway, on the following dates, Tuesday 19th April to Wednesday 20th April 2022.

The overall cost of the visit will include:

- Travel

- Climbing Wall
- Low Ropes Course

So we make the most of the time away, we will be leaving at approximately 8.30am on Tuesday 19th April and returning on Wednesday 20th April at approximately 5pm.

We have the flexibility for you to pay this in instalments on ParentPay over 6 payments. If you would like your child to go, then please visit ParentPay and pay the first instalment.

We ask that everybody pays by instalments, unless you want to pay the full amount by September 2021.

Unfortunately, due to the recent effect COVID had on the travel industry, our trip insurance no longer covers us if a child does not go on a trip even if this is because the Government has instructed schools not to go as they did last year. This means if you book a place for your child on the residential you are committing to pay for the travel, accommodation and food costs in full even if the trip does not go ahead or for any reason your child does not attend. The other activities we will be able to get refunds on as we only pay for those items when we actually go.

There will be a meeting for parents and carers before the visit, which will give you full information and details of the itinerary.
