'Young Writers – Adventure Hunters' competition.

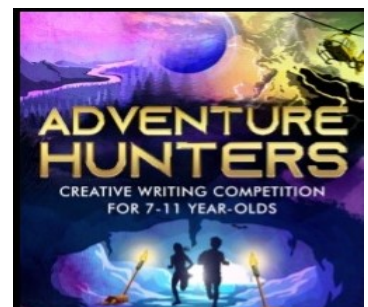
Children aged between 7 and 11 are
