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YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO LLANDUDNO BEAR AND OWL CLASS – TUESDAY 21ST JUNE – WEDNESDAY 22ND JUNE 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find below final details about our residential visit to Llandudno.

We will be leaving school on Tuesday 21st June at approximately 8:30am so children will need to arrive promptly on this date. They will return to school on Wednesday 22nd June at approximately 5:00pm however we will update you via text message and Class Dojo if there are any delays. Your child must be collected by an adult from the KS2 big yard.

If your child requires any medication during the residential, then a medical consent form must be completed and handed to the designated first aider – Mrs Elliott, on the morning of the visit – along with the medication needed. This includes any travel sickness medication which may need to be taken for the return journey on Wednesday 22nd June. Any travel sickness medication required on Tuesday 21st June should be given by parents or carers before arriving at school. All medication must be clearly labelled. Mrs Elliott will be on the Key Stage Two playground, along with class teachers, just before 8:30am on the Tuesday morning. If you require a medical consent form, please collect this from the KS2 Office before the visit.

The children need to wear their full Forest School kit or, if the weather is warm, PE shorts or skorts, with their Forest Schools top on Tuesday 21st June.

Children will need a packed lunch for the first day. If your child requires a packed lunch from school, please order this via Parent Pay in advance.



Kit List

Your child will need:

- To be wearing their Forest Schools kit for Tuesday 21st June (includes t-shirt and hoody).
- Set of clothing for Wednesday 22nd June. This should include:
 - Underwear and socks
 - T shirt
 - Joggers, tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts (you may wish to send both shorts and longer bottomed trousers in case of a change in weather whilst away).
- No skirts or dresses please.

In addition to the above, children will also need:

- A waterproof coat
- Suitable outdoor footwear for walking such as comfortable trainers or walking boots. No sandals are to be worn.
- Pyjamas and slippers/indoor shoes
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, towel, and hairbrush
- Suncream (labelled with your child's name)
- Book to read (optional)
- Sun hat
- Labelled water bottle as there are several places around the centre where these can be filled up throughout the day.
- As explained above, any medication will need to be sent with a medical form, this includes any travel sickness medication for the journey home.
- No more than £10 to spend at the arcades.
- **STRICTLY NO MOBILE PHONES/HANDHELD DEVICES** are to be brought from home. Teachers will have mobile phones with them incase of an emergency.

Please remember to label all items clearly.
